STIPENDIUM HUNGARICUM SCHOLARSHIP: 2026/2027 ACADEMIC YEAR

The Government of Hungary through Tempus Public Foundation has announced the Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship. Two hundred (200) scholarships are available to eligible Kenyans for Bachelors, Masters, One-Tier Masters and PhD tenable in 2026/2027 Academic year in the following areas of study:

- Undergraduate (BA/BSc) studies in the fields of Agricultural Science, Computer Science and Information Technology, Legal Science, Economic Science, Engineering Science, Medical and Health Science and Natural Science;
- Master's (MA/MSc) studies in the fields of Agricultural Science, Computer Science and Information Technology, Legal Science, Economic Science, Engineering Science, Medical and Health Science and Natural Science;
- Doctoral (PhD/DLA) studies in any field of interest;
- One-tier master's (OTM) studies in the fields of General Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacology, Architecture, and Veterinary Medicine.

NB: One-Tier Masters (OTM) covers both Bachelor and the Master's levels.

The provisions covered by the scholarship include;

- i. Tuition Free Education that is exemption from the payment of tuition fee.
- ii. Free dormitory place (depending on institution capacity) or contribution of HUF 40,000/month (cca EUR 100) to accommodation costs for the whole duration of the scholarship period (Please note that if the student does not live in the dormitory, the HUF 40,000/month is a contribution to the rental

costs, and in bigger cities – especially in the capital city – this contribution would not cover the full amount of rental costs.)

- iii. Medical Insurance, and
- iv. Monthly stipend as per the attached rates;
 - a) PhD students (HUF 140,000 (cca EUR 355 for the first phase of education (4 semesters) and HUF 180,000 (cca EUR 460) for the second phase (4 semesters),
 - b) Bachelors, One-Tier Masters and Masters students (HUF 43,700 (cca EUR 110) for 12 months a year until the completion of studies

Please note that these provisions covered by the scholarship DO NOT FULLY cover all the costs of living in Hungary. This is only a contribution to the living expenses and the students need to ADD THEIR OWN FINANCIAL RESOURCES. Eligibility

A. Undergraduate

- a) Minimum KCSE Mean Grade of B (plain).
- b) Age of the applicant should not be more than 25 years.
- c) Grade "B" in core subjects in the preferred field of study.
- d) Completed Secondary Education in the last three (3) years.
- e) Have original KCSE certificate.

B. Postgraduate

- a) Graduated with a Bachelor's degree upper second-class honors level for Master's and the age be below 38 years of age.
- b) For PhD, applicants must have a relevant Master's Degree and be below 45 years of age.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

All eligible candidates must read and adhere to the following guidelines strictly:

- Complete the online application at <u>apply.stipendiumhungaricum.hu</u>. After registration, the applicants are able to access the application system and upload the required documents. A guide to the online submission is available on <u>www.stipendiumhungaricum.hu</u> website. The deadline for submission of online application to the Tempus Public Foundation is 15th January 2026 (2 pm Central European Time).
- 2. Doctoral candidates are advised to visit website (http://www.doktori.hu) before applying.
- 3. Download, print the online application submitted to Tempus Public Foundation together with the Ministry of Education's STANDARD

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM available on the Ministry of Education website http://www.education.go.ke fill it and attach:

- Certified documents (photocopies of ID, Academic/Professional Certificates, Transcripts, Birth Certificate and other testimonials).
- ii. The study plan for postgraduate students/ proposal in the area of study, and
- iii. Candidates who are in service should submit their application through their Heads of Departments.

- Only shortlisted applicants shall be contacted through e-mail or phone call
 to attend the interview.
- 2. Academic Certificates from Foreign Institutions of Higher Learning MUST be recognized by Commission for University Education (CUE).
- The Ministry of Education is the designated sending partner for the Hungary Government Scholarships. It is mandatory for all interested applicants to go through the Ministry's preliminary selection process.
